As per the Regulations notified by the All India Council for Technical Education vide F.No. 37-3/Legar 2006 dated 14th Sept 2006 and from a Standards, Procedures and Conditions prescribed by if from time to time and based on the recommendation of Appraisal Committee / Expert Committee, I am directed to convex to extension of approval of the Council to Siri Venkateswara College of Pharmacy, R.V.S. Nagar, Chitton 517 127 for conduct of the following council, with the intake indicated below:

The Compliance Report along with requisite processing fee is required to be submitted every year by 31st August irrespective of the period of approval.

The above approval is subject to restriction of the following observations a deficiencies / specific conditions is 31st August 2008.

## Facilities:

- All the infrastructural facilities including classrooms, laboratories and equipment required for second year of B. Pharm programme as per the norms of the University / AICTE are to be developed before June 2008.
- Additional faculty as per norms to be recruited before the commencement of next academic session.
- AICTE pay scales should be implemented to the entire faculty.
- Senior level faculty in cadre ratio as per AICTE norms should be appointed.
- Eibrary facility in terms of books and journals are to be augmented as per AICTE norms.

Note: The mandatory disclosure in prescribed format if not hosted on the website should be hosted by 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2008, failing which action would be initiated as per the rules and regulations of the AICTE including No Admission / Withdrawal of approval.

The institution is required to submit two copies of the Compliance Report, indicating the rectification of deficiencies along with mandatory disclosure and details of faculty recruited for each course in the prescribed format (available at AICTE Websie www.gicte.ernet.in) to the concerned Regional Office latest by 31° August 2008 for consideration of approval beyond the session 2008-09. It may be noted that all the institutions are required to submit the Compliance Report along with requisite processing fee by 31st August, every year, irrespective of the period of approval.

The Compliance Report must be accompanied with a processing fee of Rs. 40,000/- in the form of demand draft in the favour of the "Member Secretary, AICTE", payable at New Delhi. In the absence of processing fee the Compliance Report will not be ententained. Following the Compliance report, the Council would verify the status in respect of recification of deficiencies through surprise random inspection without any prior notice.

The above approval, if granted after rectification of deficiencies would be subject to the fulfillment of the following general conditions:

- That the management shall provide adequate funds for development of land and for providing related infrastructural, instructional and other facilities as per norms and standards laid down by the Council from time to time and for meeting recurring expenditure.
- That the admission shall be made only after adequate infrastructure and all other facilities are provided as per norms and guidelines of the AJCTE
  - (b) That the admissions shall be made in accordance with the regulations notified by the Council from time to time.
  - (c) That the curriculum of the course, the procedure for evaluation/ assessment of students shall be at accordance with the norms prescribed by the AICTE.
  - (d) That the Institution shall not allow closure of the Institution or discontinuation of the courses, or start any new course(s) or after intake capacity of seats without the prior approval of the Council.
  - (e) That no excess admission shall be made by the Institution over and above the approved intake under any circumstances. In case any excess admission is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution.
  - (f) That the institutions shall not have any collaborative arrangements with any Indian and/ or Enreign Universities for conduct of technical courses other than those approved by AICTE without obtaining prior approval from AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Course, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution.
  - (g) That the Institution shall not conduct any course(s) in the field of technical education in the same premises/ campus and / or in the name of the Institution without prior permission: approval of AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action, including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution.
  - (h) The institution shall not conduct any non-technical course(s) in the same premises/ campus under any circumstances. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution.
  - 3 That the institution shall operate only from the approved location, and that the institution shall not open any off campus study centers/ extension centers directly or in collaboration with any other institution/ university/ organization for the purpose of imparting technical education without obtaining prior approval from the AICTE.

- 5 That the turbon and other less shall be charged as prescribed by the Competent Authority within the overall criteria prescribed by the Council from time to time. No capitation fee shall be charged from the students/ guardians of students in any form.
- 5 That the accounts of the institution shall be audited annually by a certified Chartered Accountant and shall be open for inspect on by the Council or any body or persons authorized by it.
- That the Director/ Principal and the teaching and other staff shall be selected according to procedures, qualifications and expenience prescribed by the Council from time to time and pay scales are as per thic norms prescribed by the Council from time to time.
- 7 (a) That the institution shall furnish requisite returns and reports as desired by AICTF in order to ensure proper maintenance of administrative and academic standards.
  - That the technical institution shall publish an information booklet before commencement of the academic year giving details regarding the institution and courses/ programmes being conducted and detail, of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form of mendator, disclosure. The information booklet may be made available to the stakeholders of the technical editionary or cost basis. The mandatory disclosure information shall be put on the Institution Websit. The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the institution.
  - (c) That it shall be mandatory for the technical institution to maintain a Website providing the prescribed information. The Website information must be continuously updated as and when changes take place.
  - (d) That a compliance report in the prescribed format along with mandatory disclosurer, on fulfillment of the above conditions, shall be submitted each year by the Institution within the time limit prescribed by the Council from time to time i.e. 31\* August 2007 for the current year.
  - That it Telegraphics the factor factor disclose the information or suppress and for first their the information, appropriate action could be initiated including withdrawal of ACCL appropriate.
- That all the laboratures, economic etc. shall be equipped as per the syllabrof the concerned affiness. University and shall be in operational condition before making admissions.
- 9 That a library shall be reliablished with adequate number of titles, books, journals (botts limber its foreign) etc as per AICTF norms.
- 10 That a computer center with adequate number of terminals, Frinters etc. shall be established as per-AICTE norms.
- ALCLE may carry out random inspections round the year for venfying the status of the Institutions to ensure maintenance of norms and standards.
- That the AICTE may also conduct inspections with or without notifying the dates to verify special complaints of mis-representation, violation of norms and standards, mai practices etc.
- 13 That the Institution by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become clasmant to any grant-in-aid form the Central or State Government.
- That in the-event of a student / candidate withdrawing before the stating of the course, the wait listed candidates should be given admission against the vacant seat. The entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One thousand only) shall be refunded and returned by the Institution / University to the student / candidate withdrawing from the programme. It would not be permissible for Institutions and Universities to retain the School / Institution Leaving Certificates in original to force retention of admitted students (See Public Notice/DPG/03(01)/2008).

- 15 That the institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form, in the light of directions of Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition No. (C) 656/1998. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging by the institutions, the Council shall take the appropriate action withdrawal of approval.
- 16 That the Management shall strictly follow further conditions as may be specified by the Council through various notifications in media including AICTE official website (<u>www.aicte.ernet.in</u>), from time to time.
- 17 In the event of non-compliance by the Sri Venkateswara College of Pharmacy, R.V.S. Nagar Chittor 517 127, Andhra Pradesh with regard to guidelines, norms and conditions prescribed from time to time the Council shall be free to take measures for withdrawai of its approval or recognition, without consideration of any related issues and that all liabilities arising out of such withdrawai would solely be that of Sri Venkateswara College of Pharmacy R.V.S. Nagar Chittor 517 127, Andhra Fradesh.
