

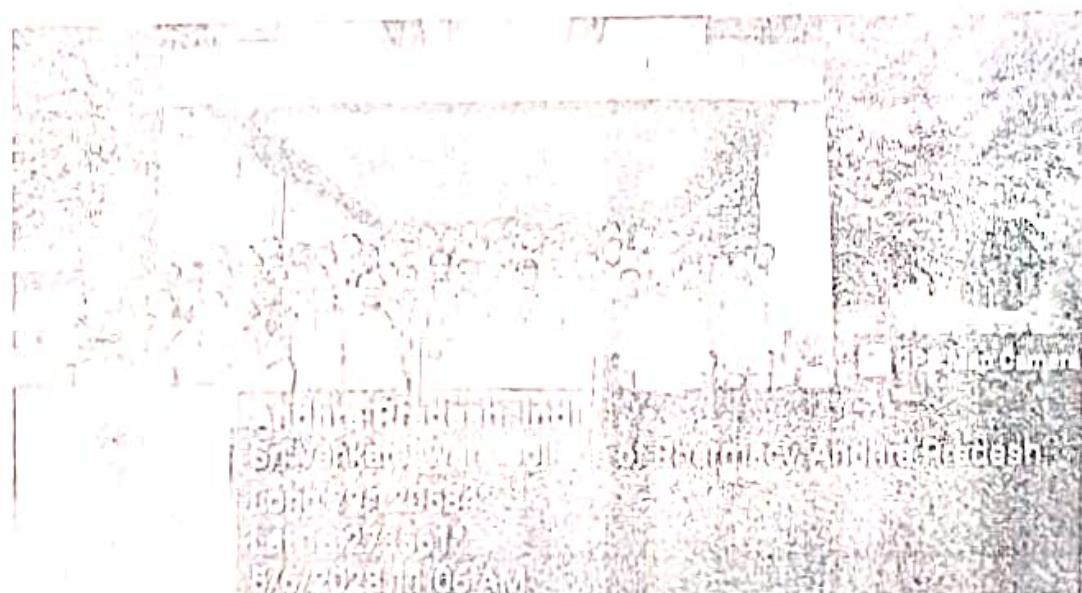
NSS Report for the month June -2023

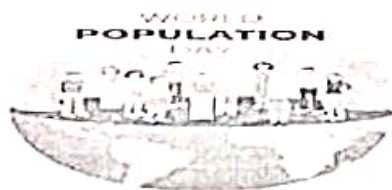

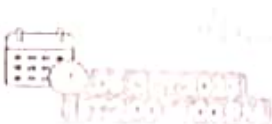

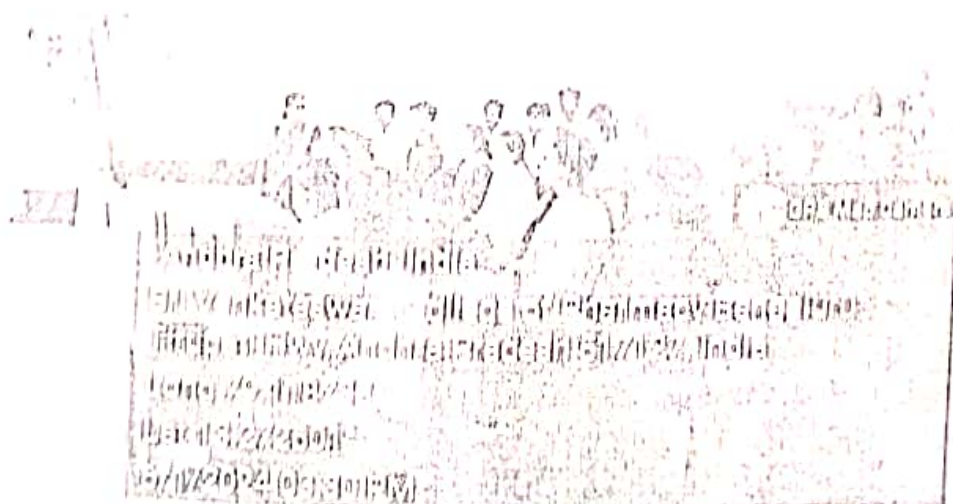

Venue: Sri Venkateswara College of Pharmacy, Chittoor.

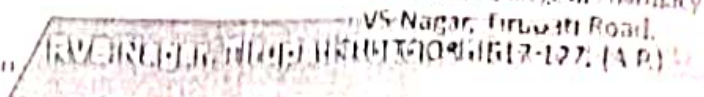

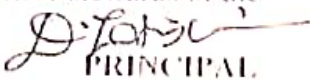
The event included the following activities:
